Plenty County, I Samuel Salter Planter of the State
and County aforesaid, being very sick and weak in Body,
calling into mind the Mortality of my Body, and know-
ing that it is appointed for all men to Die, do make
and declare this my last Will and Testament, That is
to say, principally and first of all, I give and recommend
my Soul into the hands of God that gave it, and my Body
to the Earth to be buried at the discretion of my
Executors. First my will is, that all my lawful
Debt be first paid. I then give to my beloved Son,
Benjamin Baker Salter all my Estate both Real
and Personal, to be delivered to him at the day of his
Marriage or at the Age of twenty Years, but if he should
Die before his Marriage or of the Age of twenty Years,
then I give the one half of my personal Estate to the
Children of John Baker deceased and the other half to
the Widow Abiel Holmes to them and their Heirs for
ever. My Real Estate I give to Peter Winn's Children
to them and their Heirs for ever, I Constitute no-
minate and appoint my Friends Mr Abiel Holmes,
William Baker and Peter Winn Executors of this my last Will
and Testament, & I do hereby utterly disallow revoke
and annul all former wills heretofore by me
made, In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my
Hand and Seal this 30th day of November in the
Year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and
Ninety and in the fifteenth Year of the

Testament of the United States of America
