and of sound Mind and Memory, calling to mind my mortality,
and knowing that is appointed for all men once to die, do
make and Appoint this my last Will and Testament
in manner and form following, committing my Body to the
earth to be buried with a Decent and Christianlike Burial
At the discretion of my Executors, and my soul into the hands
of God that gave it - I Will that all my lawfull
Debts be paid. I give to my Beloved Niece Elizabeth Baker
all my wearing Apparell, and further fifty five pounds or
Sterling to be paid out of my Estate as soon as possible
or convenient - I give to my Beloved Sister Margaret
Lambright my Riding Chaire, to her and her Heirs
Forever - It is my Will that all the
rest and Remainder of my Estate be equally Divided
among my three Children, Charles Dicks - -

David James Dicks, and my son Thomas Baker, to them
their heirs & assigns forever, But in case of the Death of either
of them in minority the share of such to be equally divided among
the survivors or survivor - I Constitute and Appoint my
Beloved Husband William Baker, my Beloved Sons Charles
Dicks & David James Dicks, together with my Beloved
Friends Thomas Hornby & Joseph Law Junr. Executors of this
my last Will and Testament, hereby revoking all other Wills
Testaments and Legacies whatever by me heretofore made
or mentioned Ratifying and confirming this and no other
to be my last Will & Testament -

the said Susanna Baker to be
her last Will and Testament the
13th day of March Anno Domini
