the Estate I got by his Mother, also as much of the
remaining part of my Estate as will make him eg-
ual with my Son Thomas with whatever he
may Have of my own Estate or otherwise, my Execu-
tors to make a true Appraisement of all that may
fall to each of my Sons at my decease by Law,
exclusive of what I give them by Will, that that
they may be made equal in the whole. Item
It is my Will that my old Friends William Foster
Senior, Thomas Henry Senr. Samuel Spencer, John
Winn & Samuel Brown, be Executors of this my
last Will and Testament, Revoking and
disannulling all other Testaments, wills, Lega-
cies bequests and Executors, by me in any
ways before named, Will'd & bequeathed, Ratify-
ing and Confirming this and no other to be my

and Testament. In witness whereof I
