

In the name of God Amen, I Antomas Baker of the State of Georgia County of Liberty Master here of Sound Mind & Memory do make & Ordain this my last will & Testament — Companions — It is my will that all my lawfull debts be paid out of my Estate, which if thought best by my Executors be kept together until it is done — Item — One half of the tract of land whereon I now live belongs to my Daughter Jean — the other half of which I give unto her together with confirming to her the one half of the Negroes that fell to us from the Estate of Jean Robt & Robert Le Baillie, that is to say, the Negroes that was secured or made over to her by her Mother's Marriage Settlement — Item — I give to my wife Sarah Baker the following Negroes, Vizt. Lily, Ann, Harri, Sandy, brother, Violet, Sarah, Charlotte, Dick, Bob, little Robt, Isaac & Gold Clay with their issue to her & her heirs for ever — Item — I give & bequeath to my son Antomas the whole of the Remainder of my Negroes with their Offspring forever — Item — I give unto my wife Sarah all of my household Furniture, bedding, horses & riding Chaise — Item, about one third of the Cattle I possess belongs to my Daughter Jean, the other two thirds I leave to be equally divided between my wife & Son — Item — It is my will that my wife Sarah shall live on the Plantation where I now reside have free use of the buildings & plant the land together with my other heirs during her widowhood — Item — It is my desire that my part of a Tract of Land on South Newport & the other part belongs to which I have my Lots in the Town of Brunswick, my part of the Lots in Sunbury that belonged to the Estate of Robert Le Baillie, also my part of the tract of Land on brookside River belonging to said Estate be all sold to the best Advantage to pay of my Debts — Item, I give & bequeath to my wife the Flock of Sheep together with the Stock of Hogs — Item — I give to my Brother William my Silver mounted Gun Shot pouch & all of my wearing Apparels — Item, It is my desire that the Remainder part of

April one thousand Seven hundred & Ninety two,
