

I Andley Maxwell of the State of Georgia and County of Liberty Planter, feeling the necessity of making suitable preparation for death in temporal as well as spiritual matters do therefore now that I enjoy the full use of all my faculties with humble gratitude for the worldly goods which have been bestowed upon me will and dispose of them after my decease in manner and form following viz-

1st My Personal Estate - After the payment of my just and lawful debts I give and bequeath all and every part thereof to my wife and two children and to the widow and two children of my deceased son James Andley Maxwell in manner and form following viz-

To my wife I give and bequeath one fourth part thereof to her and her heirs forever

To my son Joseph Edward I give and bequeath one fourth part thereof to him and his heirs forever

To my Daughter Julia Rebecca King I give and bequeath one fourth part thereof to her and her heirs forever

To the widow and two children of my deceased son James Andley viz Susan M. & Laura Elizabeth & Charles Edward I give and bequeath the remaining fourth part thereof to be equally divided among them, have and share alike, to them and their heirs forever

2nd My Real Estate - To my son Joseph Edward I give and bequeath to him and his heirs forever Two tracts of land adjoining containing in the aggregate 714 acres viz One tract of land containing 621 acres called "Yellow Bluff" purchased of the Estate of Thomas F Bacon (Col^l Island) and bounded North by lands of James F Baker and South by lands appertaining to this will by my daughter Julia Rebecca King Also a tract containing 93 acres purchased of Estate Thomas F Bacon Having "Yellow Bluff" on the East - See plat of the above tracts representing surveys made by Robert Hendry Jun^r D.S. completed February 22 1819

To my Daughter Julia Rebecca King I give and bequeath to her and her heirs forever the following tracts of land containing in the aggregate 707 acres acres viz One tract originally granted to Thomas Perkins for 100 acres but containing by survey 110 acres One other tract granted Thomas M'gee for 100 acres but containing by survey 119 acres - Also a tract containing by survey 174 acres purchased by me from Capt John S. Quartermaster - See a plat of the above tracts representing a survey completed by Robert Hendry Jun^r D.S. Feb 12 1819 I further give and bequeath unto my Daughter Julia Rebecca King a tract of land formerly

owned by Jos. Winn and Thos. Melle Jun^r containing 43 acres - of which 20 acres were purchased by me from Thos. Bacon 11² acres at Sheriff's sale as the property of Thos. J. Melle and the remaining 11² acres from Benjamin Melle Jun^r - See a plat representing in part a survey made at the request of Mr. Thos. Melle by Wm. Cundiff C.S. July 21st 1801 Also a tract containing 50 acres originally granted to John Winn - See titles to this tract executed to me by William Fleming Wm W. Baker & Wm H. Capels representatives to the heirs of the said John Winn deceased - One tract of 20 acres (more or less) adjoining the above tract, purchased by me of the representatives to the heirs of Peter Winn deceased Also one other tract of land containing 19¹ acres joining lands given by this will to my son Joseph Edward purchased of the Estate of Thos. J. Bacon - I further give and bequeath unto my daughter Julia Rebecca King (two lots) in the Town of Sanbury (L.C.) known and distinguished in the plan of said town by Nos 3 and 4

To Laura-Elizabeth And Charles Edward the children of my deceased son James Audley) I give & bequeath to them and their heirs forever - Four several tracts of land all adjoining containing in the aggregate 577. acres viz. One tract containing 150 acres being one half of a tract of 300 acres purchased by me of the Rev. William M^r Whitt One other tract of 137 acres with the improvements thereon comprising part of a tract of 250 acres originally granted to John Barnaby - A tract originally granted to Mary Author for 200 acres but containing by reversion 227 acres including 5 acres sold off to Col. Joseph Saw on the Half Moon Bluff - See plats of the two last named tracts representing surveys made by Robert Hendry Jun^r D.S. on the 13. & 15 days of Feb^y 1819. Also a tract of 68 acres purchased by me from the Est. Thomas J. Bacon and joining lands given by this will to my daughter Julia Rebecca King - See plat of last named tract representing part of a survey for Thos. J. Bacon completed Feb^y 20 1819 by Robert Hendry Jun^r D.S.

It is further my will. any thing contained herein to the contrary notwithstanding that my wife should & her heirs mine shall have and possess the following privileges for and during her natural life viz - The use of my present dwelling with the furniture both household and kitchen attached thereto. as much land on the plantation designated in this will to my grand children Laura Elizabeth & Charles Edward as will be necessary to employ in cultivation such slaves as may to her share in the division of my estate and the use of my carriage and pair of horses - It is further my

will that my wife have and possess the servant girl
Grace now about the house to her and her heirs forever -
to be included in and be part of the one fourth of my
personal estate bequeathed in this will to her

In token of my regard and confidence I constitute
and appoint my friend Rosewell King Jan^r and my
son Joseph Edward Maxwell Executors of this my
last will and Testament
