Item I give and bequeath to my Daughter Margaret five Shillings Sterling to her and her Heirs forever. - Item I give and bequeath to my other three Daughters Elizabeth Sordine, Susanna and Mary Brown all the Rest and Residue of my Estate, both Real & Personal whatsoever and wheresoever, I give to them and the Heirs of their Body forever. - Lastly I hereby Nominate and Appoint my Grand Son Francis Shepherd, and Friend Gideon Down, my Executors of this my last Will and Testament, Confirming this and no other to be so, published and declared this the Twenty Ninth of January One thousand seven hundred and Ninety five, to be his last Will and Testament by the said Francis Brown in presence of Us desired to Witness the Same. - And the Word Grand Daughter are Interlined. -
