and Ordain this my last Will and Testament in witness
and form following (Wit) In the first place I commend
my soul to God thro' the merits of my Saviour Jesus
Christ, & my Body to be decently committed to the Earth
at the Discretion of my Executors. And touching such
Worldly Estate as it has pleased God to bless me with
I give devise & bequeath in manner and form following.
That is to say, my will is, that my Funeral charges & all my
Just Debts be duly paid. my loving Affair not to be
appraised, but to be delivered to my Son Samuel Burnley.

Item. I Give & bequeath unto my well-beloved Daughter
Mary Ann Burnley, one Melatto Girl called Rachel &
one Tract of Land Willed me by my Father Samuel
Burnley, adjoining Lands of my Brother Thomas Burnley
be it more or less to be delivered to her at the Age of
Eighteen or at Marriage, to her her Heirs and Assigns.

Item. I Give and bequeath unto my well beloved
Son Samuel Burnley, one Negro Boy called Dick,
one Tract of Land known by the Name of M^r. Warat,
containing two hundred Acres more or less, to him, his
heirs and Assigns, to be delivered to him at the Age of
Twenty one Years. Item. I Give and bequeath
unto my well beloved Daughter, Rebecca Eliza
Burnley, one Negro Girl called Mary, & one Tract of

Land, containing one hundred and eighty Acres, adjoining
lands of Elizabeth Stearns and William Baker Stearns, to her
her heirs and assigns to be shared to her at the age of Eighteen and thence
thence, Lastly I do my will that all the remaining part of my
Estate, whether real or personal be equally divided, between
my three children before mentioned (viz) Mary Ann Burnley,
Saml Burnley and Rebecca Eliza Burnley to them and
their heirs forever. Finally I do hereby constitute
nominate and appoint my beloved son Saml Burnley,
my trusty Friends, Isaac Bacon, William Way, Joseph
Way & James Stewart, to be Executors of this my last
will and Testament, hereby revoking, annulling,
disallowing & making void all other bequest, wills,
Testaments and Legacies by me heretofore made or
mentioned, Notifying & Confirming this and no other to
be my last will and Testament.
