 die. Do make this my last will & testament in manner
 and form following viz after paying my just debts

 Daniel Baker all my stock of cattle together with all
 such money as I may be possessed of at the time of my
 death or may be owing to me the cattle to kept for
 and the money to be laid out for his use at the discretion
 of my executor hereafter named, I give and bequeath to my
 niece Sarah Baker wife of my nephew William Baker
 feather bed one mattress bolster pillows blankets and two
 quilts. I give & bequeath to my niece Rebecca Baker
 my niece Hannah Braddock all my wearing apparel
 equally divided between them. Lastly I constitute and
 appoint my nephew William Baker and my friend John
 M. H. executors to this my last will. ~~Witness~~ with
 power to see it executed in witness whereof I have
 hereunto set my hand & seal this 11th day of April
 one thousand eight hundred & three

 declared by the testatrix
