I give and bequeath to Rebecoa Ball my dearly belowed wife the plantation I mow live on in the province & parish aforesaid during her natural life, Item, I give and bequeath to my well beloved wife Rebecca Ball an equal share with my child or children both of my real and personal Estate and it is my desire if my children should live that each of them should share alike of my Estate real and Item 1t 18 NW deligion del comper www. a proper maintenance out of my Estate During his life, and likewise that my father Bartholomew Ball Should have a proper maintenance out of my Estate at the discretion of Executors - Item - it is my will that if in case my Children Should die under age that their part be equally divided between Sampson Ball, William Ball, (my brothers) and Elisabeth Thompson (Daughter of my sister Thomson) John Mikell (Son of my Sister Mikell) and the first born child of Hugh Giles by my sister -----And lastly - I appoint and ordain Rebecca Ball my beloved wife Executrix, and John Bacon, Thomas Becon, Sampson Ball, James Thomson and Andrew Walthour my Executors of this my last Will & Testament and impower them to bargain buy & sell as they shall think best.
