wife Sally Lewis All the remainder of my Estate both Real and personal
to her and her heirs and assigns forever. Lastly I do hereby nominate con-
stitute and Appoint the said beloved wife Sally Lewis, Executor and my above
mentioned nephew, Samuel Lewis, Executor and Acknowledge this and have
written to be my last will and Testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto
set my hand and seal this 24th day of January 1844
