Increase named Dinah, I leave to be equally divided
between all my Children when the first of them shall
marry or come of age, And all the rest of my personal
and Real Estate, I leave to be equally divided between
all my Children when the first shall marry or come
of age. Lastly, I hereby nominate and constitute
my beloved Friends John Way and Samuel Jones my
Executor of this my last Will and Testament, and I do
hereby give and grant unto my said Executor, power
and authority for the use, benefit, behoof and best advantage
of my said Estate, and to do as they shall Judge, will
most conuene to the Interest and welfare of my
Children, In witness whereof I the said John Foster,
to this my said last Will and Testament have set my
Hand and Seal this twenty eight day of September
in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and
ninety and in the fiftieth Year of the Independence of America.
