of the State of Georgia and County of Liberty
and in consideration of the love, good will and
affection, which I have and do bear toward
my beloved wife Sarah Harrel, Slave, and to
these present do give unto the said Sarah Harrel
the following property, one sixteen head of no
cattle, with their increase, until my decease, being
head of stock horse, all my household and kitchen
furniture; all my working tools, consisting of
pinters, choco-makers, fitters and plantation tools
1 bay horse, 1 black mare and saddle; all now in
my possession, and to come into the immediate pos-
session of the said Sarah Harrel at my decease
here and to hold the property aforesaid absolutely
without any manner of condition whatever. At the
same time hereby declaring any other deed of
gift or will heretofore made for the giving away
or bequeathing of the aforesaid property to be so
and illegally obtained, and of no effect whatever.
In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my
hand and fixed my seal this twenty first day
of March eighteen hundred and twelve.

and the certainty of death, do therefore purpose to make
and testify this my last will and testament -
First, I recommend my soul to Almighty God, who
gave it, my body to be decently buried in hopes of a
resurrection to eternal life, through Jesus Christ my
Lord and Saviour. And with respect to the property
of which God has been pleased to bless me in this
world, I dispose of it in the following manner
First of all I desire that all my just debts and
funeral expenses be paid. Item Provision to any
heirress of my estate. I desire that the sum of four
hundred and fifty dollars be reserved for the pur-
pose of purchasing land for my daughter in law,
Lydia Mallard, and her children by her late hus-
band, Lydia Mallard, for the use, benefit and be-
half of the said Lydia Mallard, and her said
children, and her and their heirs forever. Item
I give and bequeath unto my beloved wife, Lydia
Mallard, my negro boy Fred and girl Rose, my boy
Loren Fox, their and herrieff, my watch, and all
