I, Susanna M Jones, being weak of
body, but of perfect mind, do by this present make and constitute
this to be my last Will & Testament and as testifying such cordially
Estote, as at Bath Plant, God to bless me with the following manner

I give and bequeath unto my dear child Son Charles Colcock
Shaw the following negroes with their issue (to wit) Rosetta
and Simon to him and to his heirs forever, to be received by him
at the age of Twenty one years or day of Marriage, which may
first happen and in case of his dying previous to attaining to the
age of Twenty one years and not marrying; it is then my Will
that the said Two Negroes and their issue (if any) to devolve to my
daughter Susanna Mary Jones, to be received by her in like
manner

The remainder of my Negroes (to wit) Paul, M. Loughly, Annetta,
Simon, Kate, Lizzy, Betsy and Cassius (eight in number) with
their future issue I give and bequeath unto my two Children
Charles Colcock Jones and Susanna Mary Jones Shaw and shall
alike each to receive their respective proportion, at the age of
Twenty one years or day of Marriage, which may first happen
And in case of either dying previous to the age of Twenty one
years

years or day of Marriage the said issue, together with their posterity increase yet to the survivor, and in case of the death of such survivor primarily to the use of Twenty one or day of Marriage, then and as well that Two thirds of the above bequeathed Property goes to my daughter in law John Jones and the third third, to my daughter in law Elizabeth Jones

Item Such other part or remainder of my Estate as is not named in this my Will and Testament I have thought proper to dispose of in my private manner such as small articles of Silver, &c. - my Shares and by to be considered as to the purchase of my two Children my Children in Law and my beloved sister Elizabeth Maybank

Lastly I do hereby nominate and appoint my Friend and Brother in Law Joseph Jones, to act during his life as my Executor to manage all my singular, the aforesaid bequeathed Property as in his Judgment may seem most advantageous and to the discharging my debts, and at the death of my appointed Executor Joseph Jones it is my will that my Brother William Andrew Maybank, and my trusty friend James Williams do act, as Executors to this my last Will and Testament, reading all other Wills made by me
