I then I give to my beloved son James Sandiford my
Negro Man Moses

I then I give to my Grand Children, John Sandiford my
Negro boy Nimrod, to Mary E Sandiford my Girl Amy Eldest
Daughter of Sillah, to Thomas R. Sandiford my boy Cham-
-pern Eldest Son of Sillah, and to my little Grand Daughter
Mary E Law, Sillahs youngest Child Betty -
and further my faithful old servant Amy I leave to my
Daughter Mary E Law, Lastly I nominate and appoint
beloved Son James Sandiford, and my Son in Law Sam-
-l Law, Executors to this my last Will & Testament
Revoking all other Will heretofore made by me, In
Testimony whereof I hereunto set my hand and Seal this
Thirtieth Day of November Eighteen Hundred & Three
