Item... I give and bequeath unto my beloved Daughter
Sarah Persiana Maxwell, one Tract of land
containing two hundred and fifty acres

lying and being in the parish of St Thomas, but
lying and bounding as well appear more fully on
the Plat and Grant thereof, to wit, the said being
and, so also, one half part of my personal Estate
with their issue forever, and also that the my said
daughter shall have full power and authority
by virtue of this my last Will and Testament to dispose
of the said estate and the issue and income of the
same by her last Will and Testament or otherwise hereon,
save to whomsoever she may think proper

Item I give and bequeath unto my Friend James Dwyer
and James Jackson, the other moiety or one half part of
my personal estate with their issue forever, Subject nevertheless
themselves and to and upon the several trusts uses, limits,
powers and conditions herein after mentioned and not
otherwise, that is to say to the said James Dwyer
woody & James Jackson and the survivors of them
and the heirs of such survivor in Trust for the use
of my beloved Grand Daughter Sarah Simmons Abbott
for and during her natural life, With this Proviso and
Reservation, That my beloved Grand Daughter
Mary Simmons Swinton shall be paid in money, at the
expiration of Twelve months after my decease, the full
valuation of one half of the personal Estate with the
issue, herein before given and bequeathed to my said Grand
Daughter Sarah Simmons Abbott, as also one half
of the issues & profits, arising from the said Estate, for
and during the said Twelve months, or time of years
and the other moiety

or half part of the issue and profits arising from
 said Estate shall go to and be for the Sole & Separate use
 of my said Grand daughter Sarah Simmons M^{rs} Jackson
 hereby vesting with full power & authority by virtue of
 this my last Will & Testament, to dispose of her part or
 portion of the said Estate and the issue and increase
 of the same by her last Will and Testament or otherwise
 howsoever or to whomsoever she may think proper
 I then Give and bequeath unto my loving great grand
 Son William Jackson M^{rs} Intorke, One Mahogany write
 desk, one bed & furniture, to him and his heirs forever
 Lastly I do make ordain constitute and appoint
 my trusty friend James Dunwoody Executor of this
