I know all men by these persons, that said, planter, being in a low state of health, and expecting to leave this country ere long, do hereby devise, give and bequeath to my sister Mary Jones, and my nephew Saml Jones, all and every part of my real and personal estate, viz my plantation on which I now reside, known by the name of Richfield, & one tract of land in McIntosh Co. called my Cowpens, of the personal, viz cash, negroes, stock of various description, debts, dues, demands, &c. together with whatever I am entitled to possess, or may possess at any future time, to be hers and his, and their assigns, and to their proper use and behoof forever. — It is my earnest wish and desire, that this my last will and testament should be acted on, agreeable to its true intent and meaning, by my worthy nephew Saml Jones, who I nominate and appoint executor, to act for me in the premises, as directed above.
