I Micajah C. Andrews of Liberty County Planter do make and publish this
my last will and testament. hereby revoking and making void, all former
wills by me heretofore made. And first I direct that my body be decently
interred, according to the rites and ceremonies of the church and country in
which I have lived and that my funeral be conducted in a manner corresponding
with my estate and situation in life. And as to such worldly estate as
it hath pleased God to entrust me with, I dispose of the same as follows.
First I direct that all my debts and funeral expenses be paid as soon after my
decease as possible out of the first monies that come into the hands of my
executors from any portion of my estate real or personal. Also I direct that
a fair valuation or appraisement be made by three judicious neighbours of
all my estate and after being signed with their names, that a copy of the same
shall be given by them to each of my executors. And also I direct that my
son Joseph Andrews shall have ten dollars paid to him out of my estate by
my executors. And also I direct that my son Robert D. Andrews shall have
ten dollars paid to him out of my estate by my executors. Also I direct that my
Grand daughter, Virginia Daughtery shall have twenty five dollars paid to her
when she is of age or when she marries if in this country. Also I direct
that my son John I. Andrews shall have my coloured boy Ephraim to have
and to hold the same and to do with him and for him the best that he can
for his comfort and happiness. Also I give to J. P. Andrews one hundred
acres of land to be taken in the northwest or northeast corner of my tract of
land, together with a cow and yearling also fifteen head of goats and one hundred
dollars to be held in trust for the use of the before mentioned coloured boy
Ephraim. Also I direct that my son Edward B. Andrews shall have one sixth
part of my personal and real estate not otherwise disposed of, deducting from
the same the amount at which the land shall be valued by the appraisors of
my estate that I have given him. Also I direct that my daughter Mary C.
Christie shall have one sixth part of my personal and real estate not otherwise
disposed of, deducting from the same thirty dollars in value.
Also I direct that my daughter Lucia D. Baker shall have one

sixth part of my personal and real estate not otherwise disposed of, and for the better securing to her the said Lucia D. Baker the said property I appoint my son John S. Andrews trustee in trust for the same and if the said Lucia D. Baker should die childless then the said property with its increase shall return to my family and be divided between their children and grandchildren in the same manner and form as I have now given my property unto them. Also I direct that my son J. S. Andrews shall have one sixth part of my personal and real estate not otherwise disposed of.

Also I direct that my grand children, the children of my son Joseph Andrews shall have ~~the~~ sixth part of my personal and real estate not otherwise disposed of deducting in value from the same two hundred and twenty dollars, and I appoint my son John S. Andrews Guardian for the better securing to them the above mentioned children their property.

Also I direct that my grand children the children of my son Robert D. Andrews shall have one sixth part of my personal and real estate not otherwise disposed of deducting in value from the same six hundred dollars.

Also I direct that my grand children the children of my son R. D. Andrews shall have all that parcel or piece of land lying in and being bounded north by E. D. Andrews land, East by E. D. Andrews present owners, South by the Wmms land and as far west as that portion of my land may extend, and I appoint my son E. D. Andrews Guardian for the better securing to them the last mentioned children their property.

Also I direct that three of my coloured people old Phoebe, Old Tom and Fanny shall share their owners out of my heirs. Also I direct that my heirs that inherit my coloured people shall give them religious instruction from the bible.

Also I direct that my sons Joseph Andrews, E. D. Andrews, R. D. Andrews and J. S. Andrews shall be the executors of this my last will and testament. In witness whereof I hereby set my hand and seal this the 19th day of June in the year of our Lord 1843.
