 Mary is not to take her part till William is one and
 twenty of William should be under age Mary gets the
 whole if Mary dies without issue William gets the whole
 Early I constitute, name, and appoint John Whitehead
 and James McCallough Executors of the my last will, &
 Testament, and Legacies whatever by me hereof made,
 and given, and by my, and Confirming this, and none
