I Robert Hendry of said State and County being my wife
 and sick of body but being of sound mind and memory, and knowing
 that I must shortly depart from this world deem it right and proper that
 I should make a disposition of the property with which a kind Providence
 has blessed me, I therefore make this my last will and testament hereby
 revoking and annulling all others heretofore made by me

Item 1st I desire and direct that my body be interred in a decent and
 Christian like manner at the discretion of my relations.

Item 2nd I desire and direct that all my Just debts be paid as soon as my
 Executors can come the means without a sacrifice of property.

Item 3rd I direct and direct that my beloved wife Mary Hendry have the
 dwelling house and buildings attached thereto where I now reside, to
 go with the adjoining tract of land viz two hundred & eighty four
 acres taken from lands granted to Thomas Neal and Philip Tappins on
 which I now reside, three hundred acres granted to Jonathan Robinson
 fifty acres granted to Sylvanus Robinson. Twenty five acres being part
 of a tract granted to Ann Robinson. Two hundred acres granted to the
 dear Floyd and three hundred acres granted to John Underwood containing
 on its about eleven hundred & fifty acres together with my carriage
 cart, one horse and one mule, all my hogs and sheep and fifty head of
 short cattle together with such house hold and kitchen furniture and
 farming utensils as she may need - and her negroes such as she may
 choose to be for her use and support during her life then to be divided
 among all my children and their descendants, so as to make an equal
 and final division.

Item 4th My interest in the Taylors and Tappins I give and bequeath to my two sons
 John A. Hendry & George Hendry to be valued at one thousand dollars if it suits
 them to take it

Item 5th The rest of my property both real and personal, I give and bequeath to
 my two daughters Martha A. Smith and Mary E. Hendry and my six sons
 Robert Allen, Little Berry, William Wm George Nathan, Alfred Johnson
 and James Tilmans share and share alike, to them and to their respective

my former. I desired however that should my two sons John A. and Enock D. not be satisfied to take the still interest on the terms proposed, they may share it into the estate and take equal shares with my other sons and daughter.

Lastly, I constituted and approved my Brother George Hunday and my two sons John A. and Enock D. and my friends Enock Daniel and James W. Bird, Executors to this my last will and Testament this November 22nd Eighteen hundred & forty five.
