I then I give to my beloved wife Mary, the use of all my Stock of Cattle, Hogs and Horses, during her widowhood, and at her Marriage or death it is my Will that the whole thereof be equally divided among my surviving Children Male and female, in

Lastly I constitute and appoint, my trusty friends John Fuller, James Graham and John Stacy, Executors of this my last Will and Testament. And I do hereby revoke and disannul all former Wills by me formerly made, and ratify and confirm this and no other as my last Will and Testament.
