Georgia. — Know all men by these presents, that I James Smith, of the County of Liberty, and State aforesaid, in consideration of the natural love and affection, which I have and bear unto my beloved daughter, Elizabeth Dunwoody; and also for divers other good causes and considerations, me, the said James Smith, herunto moving, Have given, granted and confirmed, and by these presents Do give, grant and confirm, to the said Elizabeth Dunwoody, all, each and every of the following negro slaves, named Sam, Senant, Sony, Strap, Bram, Kenty, Lucy, Maria, Elly, Sarah, Ragget, Clarinda, Statura, Bram, Hannah, Melia, Marriah, to, Sony, Richard and Bram: To have and to hold all and every the said negro slaves unto the said Elizabeth Dunwoody, and the heirs of her body, forever: And in case the said Elizabeth Dunwoody shall leave no issue her death, the afore mentioned negro slaves shall be subject to such disposal as she, the said Elizabeth, in her last will and testament, may make. And I, the said James Smith, all, each and every of the said negro slaves, the said Elizabeth Dunwoody, her heirs and assigns, against me, the said James Smith, my executors and administrators, and all and every other persons and persons, whomsoever, shall and will warrant, and forever defend, by these presents; of each and every which said negro slaves, I the said James Smith have put the said Elizabeth Dunwoody in full possession at the time of the sealing and delivery of these presents. — In witness whereof I have put my hand and seal this twenty eighth day of March one thousand eight hundred and twelve.
