Lord eighteen hundred and nineteen.

Whereas the above bounden Baxter Smith hath this day been ap-
pointed guardian of the person and estate of Anna Matthews, an or-
phan child under the age of fourteen years, & daughter of John Matthews
late of said County, deceased. Now the condition of the above obligation
is such, that if the above bounden Baxter Smith shall, in all things
relating to, touching or concerning, the person, estate and effects of the
said Anna Matthews, as far as such estate or effects shall come into
his hands or possession, and generally, and particularly, conduct and de-
mean himself as a true and faithful guardian in the premises, and
shall render a just, true and satisfactory account of his proceedings
as guardian of the said Anna Matthews, when thereunto required,
then the foregoing obligation shall be void; otherwise it shall remain
in full force.
