

I Samuel Spence of the County of Liberty in the State of Georgia, Calling to Mind the Mortality of Man, and knowing that it is appointed unto man once to die, to make my last will and testament in manner and form following: I give and bequeath unto my wife Anne, my Children and her Children, to have, use, enjoy and should they not make her equal with my Children of what they shall hereafter receive, I state it is my will that the said Anne, of my personal Estate as well make her equal with my Children, and they also my Wife, that my Wife be allowed to live in the Plantation in which I now reside and to have a proportionable part of the said land for her to cultivate and live in natural life, I bequeath her my Gold, Silver, Jewels, Cloths and Books at Boston, and all that I give her in lieu of her Dower.

Item, It is my will that my sons and Daughters shall equally in my Estate both Real and Personal which I give unto them their heirs and assigns forever, And it is my will that my sons shall receive their proportion of my Estate at the age of Twenty Years and my Daughters at the age of Eighteen or Marriage - And should my wife be pregnant at the time of my decease it is my will that the Child or Children shall have equally in my Estate with my other Children - I constitute and appoint my trusty friends Joseph Way, Junior, William Norman, May, Elias Capshaw, Thomas Robinson, Joseph Way, my sons John and William Esqrs, and my wife Executors of this my last will and Testament, authorizing them to act in behalf of my Estate as they shall think fit.
