After my funeral expenses is paid, do wish my executors, hereafter named, to hire out my wench Elvina. I wish my wench Elvina to be hired out, and the next proceeds to be paid unto my grandson Daniel F. Sullivan, yearly, until my grandson Thos. C. Sullivan arrives at the age of twenty one; then they to have the use of the above hire of the wench; one half to Daniel F. Sullivan, and the other half to Thos. C. Sullivan, annually. I wish all my notes collected when they become due: one half I wish to be put on interest for my grandson Thos. C. Sullivan, until he arrives at the age of twenty one. Then I wish him to receive the principal and interest. The other half I wish my executors, hereafter named, to pay, as they please, to my grandson Daniel F. Sullivan, but I wish them to be the judges when he is to have it; that is, not all at once. - I give my bedding to my grandson Thos. C. Sullivan. Likewise, if my grandson Daniel F. Sullivan should die, I give the wench Elvina, with all her increase, to my grandson Thos. C. Sullivan, to him forever. Likewise, whatever money, or notes, that was not paid to my grandson Daniel F. Sullivan, I wish paid to my grandson Thos. C. Sullivan. - I likewise give to my friend, Mrs. Cynthia Melle my black silk fork pattern, and black shawl. - I give unto my sister all my wedding apparel. - I wish my horse to be at the discretion of my executors, to be done with as they please.
