Item 3rd It is my dearly beloved grand child Isiah Soper Stafford son of Command B. and Margaret Stafford of Sumner County Georgia. I give and bequeath all the real and personal of my estate, both real and personal after the payment of my funeral expenses and honest debts, to be my sole heir.

Item 4th It is my will that my negro man Loring, at my decease be sold and by the disinterested men, and then be permitted to finish his master, and that his purchase money together with the purchase money arising from the sale of all the rest of my goods and chattels, be loaned out at interest and that the interest be appropriated to the schooling board of my aforesaid son his and adopted son until he arrives at the age of (21) years by one year, at which time the principal shall be paid him with the convention that he take the name of Isiah Soper Sanford. Item 5th It is my will also that the aforesaid money be loaned in this County, and that my executor go and bring my aforesaid grand child and adopted son Isiah Soper from his father's house in Sumner County Georgia and let him to school in this County and attend to his classical and religious education.

Item 6th Should my grand child Isiah Soper die without children or before he arrives at twenty one years of age, then and in that case I give and bequeath my property given to him to my executor and his successors in office in trust however for the maintenance and education of some one other of my grand children who shall be most needy and worthy of which my executor shall be judge.

Item 7th For the better execution of my last will and testament I hereby nominate and point out my little husband and son friend Mr. Chertton Shiner of this County my executor to the same, hereby appointing all other and former wills by me made.
