and Ordain this my last Will and Testament:
That is to say, I give and recommend my soul
into the hands of Almighty God my Redeemer,
my Body to the Earth, to be buried in a Christian
and convenient Buriall, and my worldly Estate I give and
bequeath in manner following.
Item I desire my Will that all my Just debts be paid.
all my Estate Real & Personal equally between
them Thus, that my Son Richard shall have all
the Estate I got by his Mother, also as much of the
remaining part of my Estate as will make him equal
with my Son Thomas with whatever he
may have of my own Estate or otherwise, my Execu-
tors to make a true Appraisement of all that may
fall to each of my Sons at my decease by Law,
exclusive of what I give them by Will, that that
they may be made equal in the whole. Item
it is my Will that my W. Friends William B. Baker
Senior, Thomas Moore, Senr, Samuel Spencer, John
Winn & Samuel Stevens, be Executors of this my
last Will and Testament, Revoking and
disannulling all other Testaments, wills Lega-
cies bequests and Executors, by me in any
ways before named, willed & bequeathed, Ratify-
ing and Confirming the same to be my

last will and Testament. In witness whereof I
have hereunto set my hand & Seal this twentieth
day of August in the Year of our Lord one thousand
seven hundred and Eighty nine. Thomas Baker. (S.L)

It is my will, that my lawfull debt and Funeral
Charges be paid out of my Estate, before any division
of the same be made. I Give and bequeath to my
beloved Sister Sally Mee, one half of my Tract of
Land on Mowday, which I give to Her, Her Heirs
and Assigns forever.
