 constitute this my last will and testament in manner
 and form following to wit:

First My desire and will is that all my just debts
 shall be first be paid out of my Estate at the dis-
 cretion of my Executor here after mentioned

Second I give and bequeath to my daughter Lydia
 Roberts five dollars in full of her past except what
 I let her have before to her and her heirs and assigns
 for ever

Third I give and bequeath to my daughter
 Elizabeth Garrison (and if she is married I doth mean
 as who) ten dollars in full of her past except
 what I have already given her before to her
 and her heirs and assigns for ever

fourthly for the good will and affection
 I have for Robert Waller Jr for his attention
 and trouble of attending on me in my feeble state
 and time at all times and seasons I do give and
 bequeath unto the said Robert Jr all the rest of
 my Estate both real and personally or be it of
 whatever nature or quality it be so that no part
 shall remain after my just debts are paid and
 the two legacies given and before but I do give
 unto the said Robert Waller Jr to him and his
 heirs and assigns forever

Fifthly I do make and ordain Robert Waller
 Inv. my sole Executor of this my last will
 and testament and revoking all other wills by
 me made

county of Lincoln and State of Georgia being very sick
and weak in body but of sound and perfect mind and
memory thanks be given unto god Calling unto mind
the mortality of my body and knowing that it is
appointed for man once to die, do make and ordain
this my last will and testament that is to say before
all people and first of all I give and recommend my soul
unto the hand of almighty god that gave it and my
body I commend to the earth to be buried in a decent
Christian burial at the direction of my executors, nothing
doubting but at the general resurrection I shall receive
the same again by the mighty power of god and
as touching such worldly estate where with it was
pleased god to bless me in this life I give devise and
disposition of the same in the following manner and
form

First I give and bequeath to Martha my beloved
wife the whole of my property during her natural
life and after her death I give it to my children to be
equally divided between them all I do give that a sum
as may be all my just and lawful debts shall be paid
I also leave my loving wife Martha & John Hardy
her brother executors to this my last will and testament
and I do here by ⁱⁿ writing ^{make} seal to the same
