reason to be thankful for knowing the certainty of
death and the uncertainty of life I do make and
constitute this my last will and testament in manner
and form following to wit:

First My desire and will is that all my last debts
shall be first be paid out of my Estate at the dis-
cretion of my Executor hereafter mentioned

Second I give and bequeath to my daughter Indaba
Roberts five dollars in full of her part except what
I let her have before to her and her heirs and assigns
for ever

Third. I give and bequeath to my daughter
Elizabeth Pearson (and if she is married I don't think
to who) ten dollars in full of her part except
what I have already given her before to her
and her heirs and assigns for ever

Fourthly for the good will and affection
I have for Robert Walton Jr for his attention
and trouble of attending on me in my for sickness
and since at all times and seasons I do give and
bequeath unto the said Robert Jr. all the rest of
my Estate both real and personally or be it of
what ever nature or quality it be so that no part
shall remain after my last debts are paid and
the two legacies given and before but I do give
unto the said Robert Walton Jr. to him and his
heirs and assigns forever

Fifthly I do make and Ordain Robert Walton
Jr. my sole Executor of this my last will
and testament and revoking all other wills by
me made

In the name of God Amen I, Lot Hunter of this County of Lincoln and State of Georgia being very sick and weak in body but of sound and perfect mind and memory thanks be given unto god calling unto mind the mortality of my body and knowing that it is appointed for man once to die, do make and ordain this my last will and testament that is to say first & chiefly and first of all I give and recommend my soul unto the hands of Almighty god that gave it and my body I recommend to the earth to be buried in a decent Christian burial at the discretion of my Executors, nothing doubting but at the general resurrection I shall receive the same again by the mighty power of god and as Touching such worldly estate where with it has pleased god to bless me in this life I give devise and dispose of the same in the following manner and form

First I give and bequeath to Martha my beloved Wife the whole of my property during her natural life and after her death I give it to my children to be equally divided between them all I do desire that as soon as may be all my just and lawful debts shall be paid I also leave my loving wife Martha & John Hardy her brother executors to this my last will and testament and I do here by solemnly & lawfully make and declare
