4thly I give and bequeath unto my brother in law Henry Hinebrow one horse saddle & Bridle and one note of hand on Joseph Henry Gortchle containing one hundred & twenty dollars.

5thly I give and bequeath unto Henry Ray to son of Jos Ray also one thousand dollars which my father in law left me.

6thly I give and bequeath unto my mother Barbara West all the remainder part of my property to have and to hold forever.

And I do hereby appoint my brother Andrew West my sole & sole Executor of this my last will and testament here by making and disavowing all former wills by me made.

I give to my son Samuel Johnston whom he now lives I also give to my wife Leannah my three negroes namely ~~James & Duke~~ to have and to hold during her natural life and also all the stock of every kind her life except a very remainder fully I give to my son James Johnston to be delivered to him next fall at the appraisment also Samuel Johns to have his land at the appraisment also I wish and desire my

Wife Leannah to have and to hold all my household furniture and all plantation tools during her life and then to be sold and Equally divided amongst all my children so that all of them may share an equal proportion

And lastly I constitute and appoint Jacob Vicks, Spier, William Evans, Esq. and also my wife Leannah Johnston as Executors to this my last will and testament
