 West of the County of Lincoln &c. State of Georgia
 being the uncertainty of this mortal life & being of
 sound mind & memory do feel to God for the same
 do make & publish this my last Will & Testament:
 in manner and form following (that is to say) First
 I give & bequeath to my beloved wife Barbara West:
 All the property I now possess for during her natural
 - a. life (viz) Lands, Negroes, Towns &c. &c. &c.
 & back &c.

2ndly. I give and bequeath to my son Andrew West:
 Two Hundred and fifty Acres of Land more
 or less where he then lives or Lands he owns
 To him and his heirs for ever

3th I give & bequeath to my son Henry West a tract
of land where Capt. Wiper laid in the waters of
Little River containing one Hundred & Twenty
three acres more or less to him & his heirs forever

4th I give & bequeath to my Daughter Barbara
Goodwyn fifty acres of Land part of the tract
Whereon I now live joining of my son Henry
West to be her property during life —

5th At the Death of my wife Barbara aforesaid
I give and bequeath to my sons Andrew West
Henry West: my Daughter Catherine Grace
Barbara Goodwyn and Rachel Goodwyn
All the property I own or shall hereafter acquire to be
Equally Divided Among them & to be theirs &
their heirs forever except my Daughter Barbara
whom at her Death her part (given) is to be
Equally Divided between my sons Andrew &
Henry West — And I do hereby Appoint my
Wife Barbara West: my whole & sole executrix
of this my Last Will & Testament. hereby
Resolving and Decreeing all former
Wills by me made — All debts due of
I have herewith set my hand and seal this
fourth Day of March 1832 — J. B. Goodwyn
