I Bennett Haines of Lincoln County & State of Georgia Being Very Sick And Weak in body, but of perfect Mind & Memory thanks be given unto God, calling to mind the Mortality of my body And that it is appointed unto man once to die - do make And Ordain this my Last Will & Testament - And first of all I Give And Recommend My Soul into the hands of Almighty God, Whom I love it; And My body to the Earth, to be buried in a decent Christian Burial at the discretion of My Executors Nothing doubting but I shall Receive the same Again At the General Resurrection by the power of Almighty God, And As it ~~Propose~~ Relates To Such Worldly Estate Where with it hath pleased God to bless Me in this life, I Give, devise & bequeath in the following Manner Viz -

- 1st It is my wish that all My just debts be paid
- 2^d After Which I Give And Bequeath the Whole of My Estates unto My beloved Brother Peyton Haines; As follows, That Tract of Land on Which My brother Burton Haines did bring the Whole of My Real Estate, Also My horse, saddle & bridle; Wearing apparel &c - And I do hereby appoint My beloved brother Peyton Haines to be my Sole Executor of this My Last Will And Testament, And I do hereby utterly disallow, Revoke, and disannul, Revoke, and disannul all And every other former Testaments, Wills Legacies And Executors, by Me in any wise before Named: Ratifying & confirming this, And No other to be My Last Will & Testament, in Writings Whereof I have hereunto set My hand And seal this 22nd June in the year of our Lord 1832. Henry Gillum And his Heirs for ever, Also All My
Personal Estate, Writings &c. &c. &c.
