 Equally divided amongst the children, that
 she may have Living, by her present Husband,
 Lewis Hope - Lastly - I do hereby Nominate And
 Appoint Lewis Hope, My Lawfull Executor,
 to carry into Effect - this My Last Will And
 Testament - Witness My hand And Seal
 this fourteenth day of February, Eighteen
 Hundred And Eighteen -
