Wife of Alexander Mose fifty Dollars
And to there son at the Death of his Mo-
ther By the Name of Durham J. J. Mose
One Negro boy by the Name of Chester to
them & there Heirs for ever

Wife of Nathan Whitman One Negro
boy by the Name of Frank And to there Two
Sons namely Reby. A. Whitman & Peter B.
Whitman at the Death of there Mother
to be Equal divided between them One
Negro Girl by the Name of Patsy to them
& there heirs for ever

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I Give to my Daughter Mary Moore
Wife of William Moore One Negro
Man by Name of James & One Negro
Girl by Name of Leahy to them & there
Heirs for ever

I Give to my son young Behan non One
Set of Black Smith Tools And all
he has at this time or what I have
Given before to him of his heirs for ever

I Give to my son Wm by Behan non
One Acre & Two Hundred Acres of Land
known by the Name of the Forty Four
Acre Tract I now Give on

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to him And his heirs forever.

I Give to My son Rudy Bohannon Two
Hundred Acres of Land Where I now
Live And All the Appurtenances There unto
Belonging Also One Wagon & Gun To him
& his heirs forever

I Give to My Daughter Christiana
Bohannon One Negro Woman Servant &
her Two Children Antick a boy & Leah a
Girl & All their Increase & Two feather Beds
& furniture One Desk One large Looking
Glass One Sorel Horse Two cows & calves
To her & her heirs forever

I Give to My Daughter Cynthia Bohannon
One Negro Woman Servant the Name of Hannah
& her Child a Girl Named Edy & Two feather
Beds & furniture One large Looking
Glass One Bearskin Two cows & calves One
Brown Coloured Mare And their Increase
for ever To her & her heirs for ever

My Desire is at the Death of My Wife
That All the property Both Real And
Personal be Equally divided Between
My son Jacob and all My before Mentioned
Daughters Which is not in this Will
But Every One of My sons & Daughters to
have Right to hold All the property I have
Given in My will to each of them
