that it is now appointed for all men to die, I do make
this my last will and Testament
I Committ and bequeath my Soul to almighty God
Item 1st That my remains be decently buried by
my Executors

Item 2nd That my Executors pay all my last
debts. Item 3rd I give and bequeath unto my beloved
Wife Nancy Lyon two Negroes a boy named Charles
and a Girl named Henry a bedstead and furniture
one Black Mahouts Suptovars, half a dozen frames
chair, choice of Horses, two choice cows and calving
a set of knives and forks, do. Plates cups & saucers
Item 4th I give and bequeath to my beloved daughter
Sarah Lyon who intermarried with William Scale
to her and her issue to whom to my dear & Negro
Girl named Mollie, and one bed and furniture

And I do hereby Vests the rights of said property in John Moss Sr for the use of her and her heirs Item 5th I give and bequeath unto my beloved daughters Frances Lyon, Elizabeth Lyon, Minifred Lyon Nancy Lyon and Mary Lyon bed and furniture Each

Item 6th My desire is that my property remain together three years and after paying all my debts that the remainder of my property be sold and the proceeds be equally divided between my sole owning named children (viz) Frances Lyon, Hannah Lyon (who intermarried with Richard Hurry, Martha Lyon (who intermarried with Shadrach Floyd, Elizabeth Lyon, Minifred Lyon Nancy Lyon, and Mary Lyon If any of the above named children should become a purchaser of any of the property at my sale and die in Lincoln County Wills 1800 to 1832 to return back and be subject to my equal distribution among the remaining legates

Item 7th I do hereby appoint and constitute my beloved Shadrach Shadrach Floyd and my trusty friend John Moss Sr my true and lawful Executors hereby revoking all former Wills given under my hand and Seal in presence of us this twentieth day of October One thousand Eight hundred and Twenty Four
