Item 6th I Give and Bequeath to my beloved

I am the Give And Bequeath to My Beloved Sister Nancy Davis All My Real And personal estate Also All My Real and personal interest that May Arise or grow out of the three following Estates As My Legal Representative (that is to say) My part of My Beloved Father James Hughes Estate, My part of My beloved Brother Ebenezer Hughes Estate And Also My part of My Well Beloved Brother

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I am 8. I Name My Executor to collect all debts that May be due to Me, And pay off all the debts that I justly owe As soon As the Money May come into his hands -

I am 9. I do Nominate Ordain And Appoint My Truly Friend Samuel Davis My Whole And Sole Executor to this My Last Will And Testament I Witness Whereof I have set My hand And Affixed My Seal the day And year first Above Written
