As touching my worldly goods which it has pleased god to bestow on me I dispose of in the following manner that is to say I give and bequeath to my loving wife Sarah Webb all of my property both real and personal and all my outstanding debts to dispose of as she thinks proper I do appoint my wife Sarah Webb as overseer of my execution to this my last will and testament.

State of Georgia. In the name of God Amen I Henry Moore of Lincoln County and State aforesaid being now but of sound and disposing mind and memory thank god for the same yet calling to mind the uncertainty of this frail and transitory life and the certainty of death unto every one do make and publish this instrument of writing to be and contain my last will and testament in manner and form following and by land I do command to my creature and dependents for burden and convenience of all my heirs and executors a Lincoln County Wills 1796-1808 life.

everlasting through the service of my blessed Saviour Jesus Christ and my body I commit to the earth to be decently buried at the discretion of my executors hereafter named and as for such worldly estate wherof I am now possessed or entitled to through gods bounty to me I give and devise bequeath and dispose of the same as follows In presence that all my last debts and funeral expenses be fully paid and satisfied I then give and bequeath unto my beloved wife Martha all my real and personal Estate during her widowhood and I also give and bequeath unto my grand son Thomas Ware one hundred dollars at his death. I also give and bequeath unto Henry Ware son of John Ware one hundred dollars of land bearing Minon Wines land there running to a rock to interfere with the track where I do live so that is all my son John posses of my Estate. I also give and bequeath unto my grand daughter Patry Ware daughter of Nicholas Ware one hundred dollars and also my grand son Andrew Tate Ware one hundred dollars to be paid at his death and at my Wifes death the balance of the Estate to be equally divided between my children Nicholas Ware, Robert Ware, James Ware, Henry Ware Francis Ware & Sarah McLindor Patry dying.

I do here by whom shall cause to take and affix my Wife Martha & Robert Ware, James Ware Executors of this my last Will and Testament including Proving, Discharging and Making void all former Wills & Bequests by me heretofore made and declareing this day to be my last Will and testament.

In witness whereof I the said Henry Ware have to this my said Will set my hand above this 1st day of November 1801.

and sick but of perfect mind and memory thank the
giver unto god calling unto mind the mortality of
my body and knowing well it is appointed for all
men once to die do make this my last will and
testament Viz. principally and first of all I give and
recommend my soul into the hands of almighty
god that gave it and my body to the earth to be buried
in a Christian like manner at the discretion of my exec-
utors here after to be named and as touching such
worldly estate wherewithal it hath pleased god to
help me in this life I give devise and dispose of
the same in the following manner and form

first - That all my last debts be paid
secondly I leave to Nancy my dearly beloved wife
her life time or until her death all my estate both real
and personal that I hold claim or enjoy, at my death and
after her death or during her life to be divided in the manner
and following way
