 proper I do appoint my wife Sarah Webb as above
 my Executor to this my last will and testament.

 is all my son John possion of my Estate. I also give
 and bequeath unto my grand daughter Patsy Ware
 daughter of Nicholas Ware one hundred dollars
 and also my grand son Hudson Tate Ware one
 hundred Dollars to be paid at her death. and
 at my Wifes death the balance of the Estate to be
 equally divided between my Children Nicholas
 Ware, Robert Ware, James Ware, Henry Ware
 Francis Ware & Sarah McCloud. Patsy
 Lyon.

I do here by nominate constitute and appoint
 my Wife Martha & Robert Ware, James Ware
 Executors of this my last Will and intam out
 hereby revoking, disannulling and making void
 all former Wills & Bequeaths by me heretofore
 made and declaring this only to be my last
 Will and Testament.

 day of November 1804.
