5th I give and bequeath unto Henry Ray to son of Los Ray also one thousand dollars which my father in law left me.

6th I give and bequeath unto my Mother Mary West all the remainder part of my property to have and to hold forever.

And I do hereby appoint my brother Andrew West my sole & sole Executors of this my last will and testament hereby revoking and disannulling all former wills by me made.
