him and his heirs forever

Item I give and bequeath to my loving daughter
Elizabeth Edger one Negroe girl named Ludy during
her Natural life time and after her decease to her Natural
heirs of her body

Item I give and bequeath after my wife decease my
plantation to be divided equally betwixt Elizabeth Edger
and Hugh Hollingshead and his Moth Martha Hollingshead
to them and their heirs forever

Item I give unto my loving wife Elizabeth Edger
my two houses

Item I give and bequeath unto my loving grand
children Lory Burl & Polly Burl one Cow & Calf to be
paid by Martha Hollingshead and Elizabeth Edger when
they become of age

Item I give and bequeath unto my loving grand
son George Burl the forth land bounty and appoint
my loving wife Elizabeth Edger administratrix of
this my last will and testament
