for ever also one negroe man named Will in
the term of three years and there it is my request
for the said negroe man Will to be set free -
I give and bequeath to my daughter Polly Three
Negroes, Mary, Abby and Harry. and their increase
for ever

I give and bequeath to my daughter Betsey three
Negroes. Ned, Delphy and Elzy, and their increase
for ever

I give and bequeath to my daughter Fanny three
Negroes, Flora, Gatty & Denny and their increase
for ever.

I give and bequeath to my son Shepherd two
negroes. Bob & Lacey for ever

I give and bequeath to my sons Edmund
and David six Negroes, York, Luke, Rachel,
Nancy, Elbert & Delphy and their increase for
ever. The above six Negroes and their increase
to be equally divided between my two sons Edmund
and David after my decease. - Likewise my
house hold furniture and stock to be equally
divided my two sons named above.

I give and bequeath to my son Edmund two
hundred any of land lying land of Upper
Georgia and Lower Georgia and all my other
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river. Also I give and bequeath to my son James three hundred and fifty one & half acres of land joining, Sudduths Gap on and William Smiths lying on Savannah river.

Also I constitute my sons Edmund, James and son in law George Storman Executors of this my last will and testament and trustees for my children

In the name of God Amen I James Harris of the State of Georgia and County of Lincoln being sick and weak in body but of perfect and sound mind and memory thank be unto almighty god for the same but calling to mind the mortality of my body and knowing it is appointed for all men once to die, do make constitute and ordain this my last will and Testament; viz; principally and first of all I give and recommend my soul in to the hands of almighty god who gives it and my body to the earth to be buried in a decent and Christian burial at the discretion of my Executors nothing doubting but to receive the same again by the mighty power of god when soul and body are reunited at the General Resurrection and of leaving all worldly
