 Make And Ordain this My Last will And
 Testament, That is to say principally, And
 first of all, I Give And Recommend My
 soul into the hand of Almighty God that
 have it And My body I Recommend to the
 Earth, to be Buried in quiet Christian
 Burial at the discretion of My Executors
 Nothing doubting but at the General Resu-
 rection, I Shall be Raised Again
 by the Mighty power of God, And As Touch-
 ing my worldly estate Where with it hath
 pleased God to Bless me in this life -
 I Give devise And dispose of the Same in
 the following Manner And form -

First I Give unto my Beloved Daughter
 Mary Jones One Negro Man by the Name
 of Abram Which she now has in possession
 Along With All the Stock Household And
 Kitchen furniture that I have hitherto
 Given her -

I Also Give unto my Beloved Daughter
 in Law Susan Flourance One Negro Wom-
 -man by the Name of Charlotte & A Negro Girl
 by the Name of Nulda both Which she now

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has in possession Together With all the
House hold & kitchen furniture that I have
heretofore given her.

I also give unto My beloved Daughter
Peggy Blacklock one Negro boy by the
Name of Martin Which she has in poss-
ession Together With all the Stock Hou-
ehold & kitchen furniture that I have
heretofore given her

I give unto My Beloved Daughter in
Law Mary Flournoy all the Stock Hou-
ehold & kitchen furniture that I have her-
etofore given her. I also send her a Negro
Man by the Name of Ben, that she now
has in possession with her two sons Obad
and William.

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Ben is now the age of
Twenty one - I desire that the said Negro
Ben, then may be sold at the discretion of
My Executors, and the profits thereof equ-
ally divided between the said two boys Obad
and William - beloved

I also give unto My Daughter Frances
Jemie one Negro Man by the Name of Sam
Which she now has in possession Together
With all the Stock Household and kitchen
furniture that I have heretofore given her

I also give unto My beloved Son Thomas
Flournoy one Negro Man by the name of
Robt that he now has in possession of the
Tract of Land wherein he now lives

Containing One hundred & eighty six Acres
Togethr with all the Household Linen & fit-
-tlen furniture that I have heretofore given
him.

I also give unto my beloved daughter
Jane York One Negro Woman by the Name
of Jinna and one Negro Girl by the Name
of Selah both with the new Dress in her
possession Together with all the Household
and kitchen furniture that I have hereto-
fore given her.

I also give unto my beloved wife Jane
Flowerance One Negro Man by the Name of
Ben, One Negro Man by the Name of Spencer
One Negro Man by the Name of Charles, One
Negro Woman by the Name of Sarah & One
Negro girl by the Name of Dinah. One Wagg-

gon & four Horses that hath been accustomed
to Work in the Wagon, Ten head of cattle,
Ten head of Sheep & Twenty head of hogs all
& every one of her Oxen Churning, and all the
Household & Kitchen furniture & plantation
Tools except four feather beds & furniture.

I also give unto my beloved Wife Jane Flower-
ance the plantation where we now live

And I do desire that all the Part of my goods
and Chattels shall be sold to the high bidder
at public Auction or rather than the Credit of
the Payment of Sales so dividing to be equally
divided between my children.

I do hereby constitute Making & Binding

My beloved Wife Jane Flournoe the care-
 takers of My son Thomas & Moses Jones
 Executors of this My Last Will and Tes-
 tament & I do hereby utterly disallow, Re-
 -voke & disannul All & every other former Tes-
 taments Wills, Legacies, Bequests & Execu-
 -tors by me in any Way before named,
 Wills & Bequested, Ratifying & confir-
 -ming this & no other, to be My Last Will
 and Testament

 My hand & Seal this Nineteenth day of
 December in the year of the One Thous.
 -and eight Hundred & Eleven
