I give and bequeath unto my son Spinks my beloved wife during life or widowhood all the whole of my Estate both real and personal by her to be truly to be enjoyed. Then I give and bequeath unto my son Enoch Spinks one feather bed & one cow & calf and the sum of forty dollars in cash to be delivered at her death said my son Spinks decess.

Then I give unto my son John Spinks all my land it being valued and he paying one fifth of the value of said land unto my son Peter Spinks, one fifth to Wm Spinks, one fifth to Isaac Spinks, and one fifth to Zachariah Spinks to be delivered at the marriage or decess of his Mother Mary Spinks.

Then I give unto my daughter Sally one feather bed and furniture and one cow & calf to be delivered as aforesaid also the sum of forty dollars cash.

Then I give unto my daughter Susanna Spinks one feather bed & furniture and one cow & calf also the sum of twenty dollars in cash to be paid unto her as above.

Then I give unto my daughter Rebecca Evans the sum of thirty dollars in cash to be paid unto her as above.

Then I give unto Nancy Moorthy one cow and calf and the sum of thirty dollars including one rifle gun.

Then the rest of all my stock of horses and and hogs together with all my plantation utensils to be divided amongst my five younger sons & the all my children hold furniture that

shall be remaining of my Estate

Then I constitute and ordain Sarah Spinks my wife and Moses Matthews Senr. and Micajah Hendry Executors to this my last will and testament.
