 resurrection. As touching my worldly goods which it has
 pleased god to bestow on me I dispose of in the following
 manner that is to say I give and bequeath to my loving
 wife Sarah Webb all of my property both real and personal
 and all my out standing debts to dispose of as she shall
 proper I do appoint my wife Sarah Webb as above
 my Executor to this my last will and testament.
