first I recommend my soul to god, that give it.
 Secondly I recommend my body to the grave to be buried in a decent Christian burial at the discretion of my Executors, and touching my worldly affairs
 first My will is that all my last debts be paid.
 Secondly. I give and bequeath unto my beloved daughter Lane Leath one bed one cow & calf one sow & pig, which she has already received whom I appoint executor of this my last will and testament likewise I give and bequeath unto my well beloved daughter Sarah grams one cow & calf one bed one sow & pig which portion she has already received and likewise I give and bequeath unto all the rest of my sons and daughters To wit, Shantley Brown Joseph Brown, Mary Ellis, Ruben Brown, Hannah Brown David Brown, Rebekah Brown, Elizabeth Brown viz. one cow & calf, one bed one sow & pig.
 Secondly it is my will that the remainder part of my property consisting of four hundred acres of land and two head of horses and fourteen head of Cattle plantation utensils and household furniture be and remain in the possession of my beloved wife Rebekah Brown to dispose of among my children or she should think proper for the support and education of my little children also one negro girl named Helen consider it among the rest of my property all which is to remain in her possession unduring her widowhood and at her marriage or at any other time no person is to have possession of said property without giving bond and sufficient security for the due performance of the same till my youngest child comes of age at which time the balance of said property is to be divided equally among my children

recorded this will as above mentioned is to be divided equally among all my children or at her death and equal division after the death remainder part of my property among all my children is to be made lastly I appoint my son in law Elisha Porter and Sam Porter his wife Executors & Administrators of this my last will and testament.
