

State of Georgia In the name of God Amen
I Samuel Mutton Sr of the County and
State of said do make this my last will and testament
I first appoint Thomas S. Murray and Fanny Mutton
my beloved wife jointly Executors and trustees to this my
last will

Item 1st I bequeath and give to my beloved wife all that
parcel or tract of Land wherein I now live containing Six
hundred and Eighty six acres more or less to have and to
hold, enjoy and possess in her own right during her natural
life after her death, I give and bequeath the said Land and
all the improvements and every part thereof to my beloved son
Sutau Thomas S. Murray and his heirs and assigns for ever,
I further desire and request that the said tract of Land
shall not be rented nor leased during the life of my wife
Fanny Mutton nor any part thereof (whatsoever)

Item 2nd I bequeath and give to my beloved wife eight neg-
roes to wit George, Patty, Lewis, Billy and her four children
(viz) Allen, John, Peter & Barbara to have and to hold and
enjoy the same for the term of years and during her natural life
at her death the same to be divided equally among Billy, Allen

and John as she please being her property for ever, the other
negroes to wit George, Patty & Lewis, I give and bequeath to Tho-
S. Murray after the death of my beloved wife, I further
desire and give to Elizabeth A. Murray after the death of
my beloved wife the negro Girl named also the negro boy
Pew to James Murray son & daughter of Thomas S. Murray

Item 3rd I give and bequeath to my beloved son Sautau Tho-
S. Murray Elmer, Morris (son of) Edmund, Andy, Levee,
Richd. Saml. Isaac, Harry, John, Selous, Simon & Whigby
to have and to hold the said negroes and their increase
for ever

Item 4th I give and bequeath to my beloved wife the wagon
and team also the big cart and big horse of span also
the gig and gig horse

Item 5th I give and bequeath to my beloved son Sautau
Tho S. Murray the gun, the iron, the steel, the
small horse of span and cart

Item 7th I desire and request that my stock of every kind be equally divided between my beloved wife and my son Tho: S. Murray, also all of my plantation tools to be equally divided between my wife & Tho: S. Murray also my Gun I design for the use of them both to remain where it is.

Item 8th I give and bequeath to my beloved wife all the household and kitchen furniture which I possess.

Item 9th I desire and request that the corn and fodder on the plantation be equally divided between my beloved wife & Thomas S. Murray.

Item 10th I desire that all my just debts be paid off by my Executor, out of any of my notes or accounts or any property they may think proper to dispose of. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & affixed my seal this 1st day of April in the year of our Lord Eighteen Hundred & Twenty five & signed sealed & acknowledged
