Wm. O. Jones, I Oliver Luter of the County of Lincoln
and State of Georgia being in a low state of health
but in perfect sense and memory Thanks be to god
for it do make and ordain this my last will
and Testament in the manner following
first of all I bequeath my soul into the hands
of almighty god who gave it

Secondly I give and bequeath unto my beloved
wife Mary Luter during her life time all my
lands and stock of every kind horse hold and
kitchen furniture and plantation tools one feather
bed only excepted which I give and bequeath to my
beloved son William Luter at my death and at
the decease of my wife real estate to be divided
between my three sons in the following manner
To my son William Luter one third part of land

when he now lives and to Samuel Eaton one hundred
 acres where he now lives and to William Eaton one hundred
 and seven, when I now live and one hundred and forty
 acres of pine land lying below and adjoining of which
 four mads belonged to William Jennings but he and
 the whole of my personal property to be equally divided
 after paying all my last debts between all my sons
 and daughters excepting one David Colpa I give and
 bequeath unto my little nephew William Jennings and
 I do hereby constitute and appoint my loving wife
 sole executrix of this my last will and testament
