To my son Thomas Gillum I give and bequeath, two Negro Boys one named James and the other Steffy, one feather bed and furniture one horse and saddle of the value of one hundred and twenty five dollars, this sum to be raised out of my stock; viz, of cattle sheep and horses to be sold by my Executors with-
 - out Inventory or appraisment, having, confidence in them, to do the same as the sever alive my self - the balance of my stock horse hold and kitchen furniture, (except such as may hereafter be mentioned) I leave and bequeath unto my wife Mary Gillum, during her life time, and at her death to be equally divided between my son Henry, daughters Elizabeth and Sarah Gillum.

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Item third To my wife Mary Gillum I give and bequeath unto my daughter Nancy Jones Walton, one Negro Woman named Agnes, one Negro boy named Gabriel and three horses, to the use of her body for ever -
 Item the fourth To my daughter Elizabeth Jones Gillum I give and bequeath one Negro boy named, Jacob, one named William and one Negro girl named Jimmy, one feather bed and furniture, my bay horse and one saddle, one cow and calf, &c. &c. and her heirs for ever -
 Item the fifth To my daughter Susan nee, William Gillum, I give and bequeath, one Negro boy named Estlin, one Negro girl named Charlotte and one Negro boy named Battler, one horse and saddle, one cow and calf, one feather bed and furniture, to her and her

Two heirs for ever, (Item the fifth,) To my Grand
 Daughter, Mary Ann Gillum I give and bequeath
 One Negro Boy named Patrick, To my Grand Son
 Henry Gillum, I give and bequeath, One Negro boy
 named Thomas, ~~And~~ And to my Grand Daughter
 Elizabeth Gillum, One Negro boy named Simbo,
 To have and their heirs forever - the above men-
 tioned Negro boys named Patrick, Thomas and
 Simbo, To be kept by my son Henry Gillum and
 Robert. L. Walton, until the said. Mary. Ann. Henry
 Elizabeth Gillums become of age. ^{And} Marries to be
 fixed by the said Henry Gillum and Robert. L.
 Walton at their discretion, And the proceeds of
 the said to be kept for the sole use of the aforesaid
 mentioned, Mary. Ann, Henry and Elizabeth,
 Gillums until they become of age or marry -

Item 1st I Give And Bequeath unto My beloved Brother William Wright Fifty Dollars -

Item 2^d I Give Every Earthly thing I possess to be divided Between My two Brothers Josiah Wright And William Wright, Each one of the fifty dollars Above Mentioned, And I do hereby Appoint My two Brothers Josiah Wright And William Wright, the Whole And Sole Executors to.

This My Last Will And Testament. And do hereby utterly disallow, Revoke All And every Other former Wills And Testaments Legacies And Bequests, Ratifying And Confirming this My Last Will And Testament -

In Witness Whereof I have here unto set my hand
