knowing it was once appointed unto men to die
& being in my perfect mind & memory do make
and ordain this my last will and testament
that is to say first to pay all my just debts
I leave to my dearly beloved wife Judith Brown
for her & children the whole of my real and personal
estate which I am or may be possessed of
whatever kind it may be during her natural
life or marriage & at her death or marriage
to be divided among my four children and
my grand son William Augustus Anthony
as follows (viz) My will is for my land
to be valued or sold and the profits arising to
be divided between my two sons James Edward
Aycock & Lorenzo Richard Aycock at my wife's
death or marriage, also my personal property
as follows Lincoln County Wills 1800 to 1832 have this
Signed by me this day of January 1816 there is no
witness to him and his heirs for ever also to Betsy,
Jerry, Robinson Pig, Caroline Peter Phettie, Anna
and their increase to her and her heirs forever
also I give my daughter Susanna, Eliza Aycock
Edward Scotty Charlotte Rawson & Patty to her and
her heirs forever, to my son George Rich Aycock
I give Philicia Jane Rachel Buchanan instead
to him and his heirs forever &
then I give to my grand son William Augustus
Anthony Two Negroes Henry & Noora them & their
increase one black, one bed & furniture also one
cow & calf but if he dies before the comes of age
the negroes & other is to go to my four children
living before mentioned &

I hereby appoint James Edwards his trustee as
he can't death his guardian for my son James
Edwards my cock. I will also at the death of my
Wife or Marriage that all my other property of
whatsoever kind it may be shall be equally di-
vided between our four children herein before mention-
ed out of which James has had a horse saddle
& bridle, and Nancy has had one feather bed and
furniture also one cow and calf but this division
is not to take place in none of the property unless
her death or Marriage or she should be disposed
to let them have and part thereof while she is
living. Lastly I leave my Judith Crawford my
only executrix and James Edwards her brother
Executor to this my last will and testament.
