

I give to my son Samuel Johnston whom he now lives I also give to my wife Leannah my two negroes namely ~~James & Dela~~ to have and to hold during her natural life and also all the stock of every kind her life except a long remainder fully I give to my son James Johnston to be delivered to him next fall at the appraisment also Samuel Johns to have his land at the appraisment also I wish and desire my wife Leannah to have and to hold all my household furniture and all plantation tools during her life and then to be sold and Equally divided amongst all my children so that all of them may share an equal proportion

And lastly I constitute and appoint Zachariah Spier, William Evans Esq. and also my wife Leannah Johnston as Executors to this my last will and testament

In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this twelfth day of March one thousand Eight hundred offine and in the twenty ninth year of the American Independence signed sealed and acknowledged by him the said Alexander Johnston to be his last will and testament in the presence of us who have hereunto subscribed our names as witnesses on the day and date within written

In the Name of God Amen I Robert Larnett of the State of Georgia and County of Lincoln being Weak and frail of body but of perfect mind and memory do make and ordain this my Last will and testament in manner and

fore following To wit

first after discharging all my just debts I give under bequest to my affectionate wife Patsy during her Widow hood six Negroes, to wit, Lot, Mall, Isaac, Tom, Fan & Sunday, also my Stock of hogs Cattle and horses excepting a two years old horse and a mare two years old and a little gray horse which may be sold or all of which to be continued on the plantation together with all working utensils and house hold furniture excepting one feather bed a pear for my new child, Lorden, Patsy, Robert, Betty, Sally, Hardy, Absolam, Polly, and Emey which is now with me at the time of this marriage or going to themselves, as also one Negro a pear at the same time. To my daughter Nancy Macklary I give and bequest a certain Negro girl named Linda. To Lorden my son I give and bequest a Negro boy named Plumber, to Patsy my daughter I give and bequest a Negro girl named Eastern.

To Betty my daughter I give a Negro girl named Milly

To Robert my son I give a Negro boy named Squire.

and To Sally my daughter I give a Negro boy named Isaac.

and for my other four children viz, Absolam, Hardy, Polly & Emey if there should be an increase of the above mentioned Negroes to be left on the plantation then and in that case the four last mentioned children is to receive one a pear of the said increase of Negroes but in case there should be no such increase as aforesaid then the said Absolam, Hardy, Polly and Emey shall be entitled to the value of one such Negro apiece as the other have received in property or cash, and at the death or inter marriage of my wife Patsy I do hereby give and bequest unto my daughter

Peggy Haas make the sum of two hundred twenty
two dollars & fifty cents as her part in full of my
my estate which she is thus entitled to receive and
not before and the remaining part of my estate
both real and personal I leave to be equally
divided between my two children. To wit; Francis,
Landon, Patsy, Patsy, Sally, Robert, Hardy,
Abraham, Polly & Henry at the death or interment
as appears of my wife each child shall there
receive their equal part and such of them who
may be under age their part shall remain in
the hands of Landon Lamerett and John Macklin
and I do hereby nominate and appoint Patsy La
merett my wife, Landon Lamerett and John
Macklin my Executors and Executors to carry
this my last will and testament into full effect

1806.
