and personal that I hold claim or enjoy, at my death and
after her death or marriage it to be divided in the manner
and following

Suzannah, Thomas, Elizabeth and Richard. I give & bequeath unto them all the property, the property that they have received from me by gift and nothing else and to my son James one cow and pigs out of my stock after my decease and I give and bequeath unto my son Samuel all the land between Success line all the improvements appertaining thereto it being a part of a two hundred acre Survey granted to me in the year 1788. which I freely give and bequeath unto him his heirs and assigns in fee simple forever and the rest of my estate to be equally divided between Stacey, Kitzlick, Samuel and Hannah only Stacey to have one bed more than equal share and lastly I ordain constitute and confirm my dearly beloved wife Stacey and my son Thomas my Executors of this my last will and testament
